## <u>Classdojo</u>

This year we will be again using Classdojo as a means of communication and connection to the classroom. For parents that connected last year you will already be connected to our new classroom. For those of you new to Classdojo a code will be sent home which will allow you to connect to our classroom. Classdojo provides a snap shot into our daily activities with photos and messages to keep you up to date with what is happening in stage 2. In addition to this it provides a message service so you can contact us if needed. Classdojo was a great success last year and we are looking forward to utilising it again this year.

#### Homework & Home Reading

Homework will be given out at the beginning of the week and needs to be handed back in each Friday. The homework will give children practice with their spelling words and timestables. Homework is an important part of your child's schooling life and we strongly encourage parents to ensure their child completes it.

Students are strongly encouraged to take a home reader as part of their homework. They may also read a book of their own choice. Please record this on their Home Reading log which will be sent home next week.

#### **Rewards**

We will be implementing a range of reward systems whereby students who do the right thing, produce quality work, give 110% etc. will be acknowledged. This is designed to inspire a positive mindset and encourage independence, teamwork, resilience and a positive attitude to learning.



## **National Testing**

You will be aware that Year 3 is a year where a national test in Literacy and Numeracy is administered, NAPLAN. This will take place in Term 2.

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#### **Resources**
