#### NAPLAN

Next term, our students in years 3 and 5 sit for NAPLAN. The data from this point in time assessment provides directions for us as a school and is used to inform our teaching and learning. The results of the tests provide important information to schools about what each student can do, and are used to support teaching and learning programs. Parents receive a report indicating their child's level of achievement. Each student's achievement will be against the national reporting bands, national averages and national minimum standard. In advance of taking NAPLAN Online, students and parents are invited to use the public demonstration tests to familiarise themselves with the type of questions and related functionalities available in the NAPLAN Online assessment.

Some of the key features include a range of question types, onscreen tools, timers and interactive navigation. Students are encouraged to try all the tests for their year level to practise the complete range of question formats available in the online assessment.



















# P & C NEWS
