

Year 5 and 6 Camp 2019 **SUNSHINE COAST RECREATION CENTRE**

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

Please find below the details and information regarding the **2019 Grade 5/6 Camp**. The aim of the camp is to help develop teamwork and social skills and is also intended to support student outcomes in the Key Learning Area of Personal Development, Health and Physical Education.

TRAVEL: The camp will take place in the **last week of Term 3.** The children will be travelling by coach leaving Cudgen PS at 8.00am on **Tuesday 24th September** and returning on **Friday 27th September** at approximately 3.00pm. Once at the camp, no other travelling will occur outside the venue.

<u>ACCOMMODATION:</u> The children will be staying at the **Sunshine Coast Recreation Centre** at Currimundi, just north of Caloundra. The children will be accommodated in dormitory style rooms with their own ensuite facilities.

<u>MEALS</u>: All meals will be provided, starting with lunch when we arrive on the first day. Meals include breakfast, lunch, dinner, morning and afternoon tea and supper. Any specific **dietary information** should be documented on the Medical Information Form provided. As a treat, we will aim to stop at a **McDonald's for lunch** on the way home on Friday 27th. This will be the only additional money students will need on the camp.

FUNDRAISING: Fundraising for the excursion will begin early in Term 3. Details TBA.

<u>COST</u>: The cost of the excursion will be **\$330 per student**. To assist parents in this area, a payment schedule is included overleaf with **five instalments** and an **\$80 deposit**. If any parents are experiencing difficulty in this area, please contact the school to discuss the matter.

Please note as the school is expected to pay a non-refundable deposit for the accommodation, each student's deposit will remain non-refundable.

PARENT INFORMATION NIGHT: A parent night will be held the week before Camp (date TBA) to outline the excursion and answer any question parents may have. The night will be held in the school library.

MEDICAL INFORMATION: A medical information form is included. Please complete this form and return it to school with your child's permission note.

SUPERVISING TEACHERS: There will be a total of four supervising teachers/school staff attending.

Unstructured swimming is free swimming on celebration or reward days, or free swimming as part of or added to:

An excursion. A school carnival A school camp, or A weekly swimming program

This excursion will involve the following unstructured aguatic activities: Free Swimming

Prior to participation all students nominated on this form by their parent/caregiver as a swimmer will be required to participate in an aquatic pre-activity water survival challenge to look at your child's aquatic proficiency.

The aquatic pre-activity Water Survival Challenge comprises the following continuous progression – a slide in entry, a walk of 5m in shallow end of pool, a swim of 25 metres using a recognised stroke and 1 minute float, scull or tread water in deep water followed by an unassisted exit.

Students nominated by their parent/caregiver on this form as a non-swimmer will not be allowed in deep water and will not have to do the water survival challenge.

At the completion of the Water Survival Challenge your child will be issued with either:

- Blue wristband allowing them to participate in deep water unstructured activities
- Yellow wristband allowing them to participate in shallow water (waist deep) activities.

Any student who is not permitted to go in the water or is not able to walk safely in the water with balance and stability will not take part in any water activities. Appropriate non – aquatic activities have been planned for these children

PREFACE

Excursions form an important part of the curriculum covering a variety of KLA's across all grades. Each excursion must comply with the guidelines set by the Department of Education and Training. As such Risk Management is a key issue, which is central to the planning of any excursion.

DEFINITION

All students are eligible to attend excursions as they arise throughout the year. If however a student's behaviour has demonstrated that they have on a number of occasions been unable to comply with the School's Code of Conduct, their invitation to attend excursions may be withdrawn at the Principal's discretion in consultation with the Grade Supervisors and Assistant Principals.

Any student, who has been placed on a formal school detention on a number of occasions, has been placed on internal suspension or been the subject of a period of formal suspension from school can expect that their participation in any school excursion will come under review. End of year excursions, inter school participation, school sports teams and subject based excursions are all considered under the umbrella of this policy.

EXPECTATIONS

The Cudgen Public School Code of Conduct will apply throughout the duration of all school excursions. In addition to these activities, the following rules will apply:

- students must behave at all times in a manner that brings only credit to themselves, their families and the school.
- no swearing, noisy, disruptive, dangerous or other unsuitable behaviour at any time.
- follow teachers' instructions at all times.
- students must wear the full school uniform at all times unless otherwise instructed.

Breaches of any school rule, special rules (above), or any failure to act responsibly on the part of any student, will result in immediate disciplinary action by the teacher in charge. This may involve parents being contacted and/or the student being sent home at additional cost to the parents. Subsequent disciplinary action will be at the absolute discretion of the Principal. By signing and giving consent to the participation of their student to this activity, the parent/guardian and student are agreeing to be bound by the terms, rules and conditions outlined above.
