Once again we will be holding our annual school athletics carnival at Kingscliff High School.

Our Coastal Learning Community is working together to give students a variety of experiences and this event will strengthen the link between our primary students and the high school. It also provides the opportunity for all track and field events to be run on the same day with help from a number of the staff and students at KHS.

A bus will be provided to take our students from Cudgen PS to KHS at no cost. Year 3-6 students (and any Year 2 students turning 8 in 2019) will leave Cudgen at 9:00 and return in time for afternoon buses. K-2 (except those turning 8 in 2019) students will leave Cudgen at 9:15 and return at around 1:30 for lunch and the afternoon session.

The P&C will be running a canteen and a coffee van will be available too. Novelty events will be held for the K-2 students around their races which begin at 11:30. Unfortunately there is no parking available in the high school car park. There may be some parking in Yale or Oxford Streets or at the TAFE.

Students are to wear house colours, bring hats and take part in as many events as possible!! Please ensure your child has plenty of water, recess & lunch or money for the canteen.

Our whole staff will be attending the carnival so there will be **NO** supervision at Cudgen Public School on the day. If you are taking your child straight to the carnival please report to class teacher so attendance can be recorded.
