

## Year 5 and 6 Camp 2019 SUNSHINE COAST RECREATION CENTRE

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The Year 5 and 6 Camp for this year will be held at the **Sunshine Coast Recreation Centre**. It is located between Currimundi Beach and the mouth of Currimundi Lake (just north of Caloundra) and has recently undergone a \$7.1 million facelift, with accommodation, dining and activity facilities receiving a major overhaul.

An indoor rock wall and a two-story caving system, which is the first of its kind in Australia, have been added to the extensive list of activities on offer such as canoeing, high ropes and raft building.

Greater detail will be provided to parents and caregivers when school returns in Term 2 in regards to medical, diet, itinerary, what to pack and payment schedules.

DATE: **Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> September – Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September**, 2019 (*last week of Term 3*) COST: **\$330 (approx.) per student** (*inclusive of all transport, meals and activities on site*)

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- Students will need to sign a behaviour **Code of Conduct** form which they must adhere to at Camp. Students are also encouraged to continue with their display of positive behaviours at school to ensure they remain eligible to attend.
- A **payment plan** can be arranged for parents wishing to pay in instalments. For example: 7 x \$50 payments every 2-3 weeks will allow for complete payment on time.
- **Payment support** requests MUST be in writing and submitted to the office early in Term 2. Requests will be reviewed and arrangements will be mutually decided.
- This payment may also be reduced with **fundraising** by our Year 5 and 6 students. Students and parents, please suggest some ideas to Mr Baxter and Mrs Turrell!
