

Swimming/Life Saving 3-6 2022

As part of the Sporting Schools program children in Years 3-6 are being offered the chance to participate in swimming lessons or Life Saving/swim squad lessons for 8 weekly sessions on Friday afternoons, 11th February -1^{st} April. The children will be transported by bus to and from the Casuarina Beach Rec Club each Friday for a 1 hour lesson.

Tuition, which will be provided by qualified coaching staff, is specifically aimed at enhancing and educating children in the dangers of aquatic environments and develops skills to prevent drowning and assist in water rescue and survival. There is also the opportunity for learn to swim groups and stroke correction. A swimming assessment will be held to determine each child's swimming ability and group placement.

Cost includes bus, pool entry and lessons for 8 weeks, \$85 total per child.

This program is being subsidized by a grant from NSW Sporting Schools and is an excellent opportunity for children to learn to swim, improve swim strokes and develop safety skills in the water.

If you would like your child to participate in the Swimming/ Life Saving program for school sport this term please return the note below to school by Thursday 10th February, including the \$85 total cost.

The program begins THIS FRIDAY 11th February 2022. This program can cater for a maximum of 50 students.

Once maximum numbers are reached the program will be closed.
